In the early hours of Wednesday morning the Burton to Ashby tram rolled out of control and injured many people. The terrible incident occurred on the 8th October on Bearwood Hill. Sixteen passengers were taken to hospital and two of them, in-

cluding the conductress, Miss Lillian Parker, sadly, died. An eyewitness, Mr. Harry Bannister quoted, "I was just walking down Bearwood Hill

when I heard a terrible rumbling sound. As soon I saw the out-of-control tram I ran to the police station" Detectives are investigating the matter further.
