

Tram Crash!!!

Earlier today, October 8th 1919 at 11:30am a Tram, ran out of control in Bear wood Hill. The conductress Lillian Parker, had to have her leg amputated and one passenger passed away.

As the passengers were waiting for the tram, the driver was unable to control the vehicle. As reported from three local residents, it was a shock

for everyone, here one reports: "I didn't think it was going to stop, at first, it seemed like it was meant to roll back, but then we all heard a BANG! and smoke came sizzling out."
